Role of the Advisor

The *Student Conduct Code* affords all students involved in the University student conduct process the right to an advisor. The term "advisor" means any one person chosen by the responding student or reporting individual to assist them throughout the student conduct process. Regardless of who a responding student or reporting individual chooses to advise them the advisor **cannot** speak for a responding student or reporting individual in the hearing unless authorized by the hearing body. However, a responding student or reporting individual may consult with their advisor at any time during the hearing. This consultation must take place in a manner that does not disrupt the proceedings. If an attorney is to be the advisor, the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities shall be notified three business days prior to the hearing.
